HB 96	PYLANT	CIVIL SERVICE/STATE: (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to state civil service, including providing that employees hired on or after January 1, 2020, shall be in the unclassified service
HB 139	DWIGHT	CRIMINAL/RECORDS: Provides relative to fees for processing background check requests
HB 211	HORTON	MEDICAID: Provides relative to Medicaid coverage of certain behavioral health services
HB 248	CHAD BROWN	CHILDREN/CUSTODY: Provides for parenting coordinators in child custody proceedings
HB 320	SIMON	HEALTH/BEHAVIORAL: Provides for access to applied behavior analysis providers in schools
HB 327	JAMES	CRIMINAL/RECORDS: Prohibits the disclosure of certain information by law enforcement officers or employees of a law enforcement agency
HB 336	LYONS	HEALTH/BEHAVIORAL: Exempts certain school-based behavioral health service providers from the Behavioral Health Services Provider Licensing Law
HB 388	MIGUEZ	PUBLIC RECORDS: Prohibits disclosure of certain personal information in public records
HB 423	EMERSON	LICENSING: Provides for the revocation of occupational and professional licenses for failure to pay student loans
HB 503	EDMONDS	LICENSING: Provides relative to licensing qualifications
HB 554	GAROFALO	PUBLIC RECORDS: Provides relative to public records
SB 29	CORTEZ	FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS: Provides relative to professional and occupational licensing boards and commissions. (8/1/19)
SB 66	RISER	PUBLIC MEETINGS. Provides relative to open meetings of public bodies.
SB 78	MARTINY	SCHOOLS. Provides relative to behavioral health services provided to students.

SB 97	BISHOP	CRIMINAL RECORDS. Provides for "clean slate" limited access to a person's criminal history record relative to certain misdemeanors.
SB 119	COLOMB	HEALTH SERVICES: Creates the "Palliative Care Interdisciplinary Advisory Council".
SB 187	MILKOVICH	STATE AGENCIES: Provides relative to the conduct of adjudication hearings involving and the re-creation of certain state boards and commissions which issue licenses, permits, or certificates.
