ADDENDUM TO CONSENT AGREEMENT AND ORDER

WHEREAS, Michele Marie Guidry (“Ms. Guidry”) is a credentialed social worker subject to the jurisdiction and rules and regulations of the Louisiana State Board of Social Work Examiners (the “Board”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a complaint and an administrative investigation, Ms. Guidry has indicated her desire to resolve this matter through an Addendum to Consent Agreement and Order as provided for in Rule No. 907 of the Board’s Rules, Standards and Procedures and La. R.S. 49:955(D) of the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Guidry has admitted the following:

1. Ms. Guidry is a Licensed Master Social Worker (“LMSW”), licensed by the Board to engage in the practice of social work in the State of Louisiana pursuant to the Social Work Practice Act, La. R.S. 37:2701 *et seq.*, as evidenced by License No. 8431.
2. On or about June 19, 2009, Ms. Guidry signed a Consent Agreement and Order (Agreement) to resolve Complaint No. 2009-82.

3. As part of the Agreement, Ms. Guidry agreed to be evaluated by the Louisiana State Board of Social Worker Examiners' Impaired Program ("IPP") and follow all recommendations of the designated IPP evaluator.
4. Ms. Guidry was released from the IPP on January 15, 2016.
5. Pursuant to the Agreement, Ms. Guidry was placed on probation until such time as she successfully completed one hour of monthly supervision, at her expense, for two (2) years, starting from the date she resumed practicing social work.
6. To date, Ms. Guidry has only completed six (6) months of the required two (2) years of monthly supervision.

WHEREAS, Ms. Guidry has indicated her desire to resolve this matter through an Addendum to Consent Agreement and Order;

WHEREAS, the undersigned Assistant Attorney General has confirmed the respondent's desire to resolve this matter through an Addendum to Consent Agreement and Order;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in consideration of the foregoing and pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by La. R.S. 49:955(D), the Board orders and Ms. Guidry accepts the following administrative action which is an Addendum to Consent Agreement and Order dated June 19, 2009, and which is a final decision pursuant to La. R.S. 49:958:

1. Ms. Guidry shall remain on probation until she successfully completes the remainder of the monthly supervision.

2. Ms. Guidry shall complete the remaining Eighteen (18) months of her monthly supervision within Thirty-six (36) months from the date she resumes the practice of social work. Ms. Guidry shall receive one (1) hour of monthly supervision at her expense. The supervisor shall submit quarterly progress reports to the Board by the 15th of the month following the end of the quarter. Ms. Guidry shall submit to the Board the name of the potential supervisor and his/her resume prior to returning to the practice of social work. The potential supervisor shall submit a letter to the Board stating his/her acceptance of the provision of said supervision and stating he/she is not, or previously has not been, professionally or personally affiliated with Ms. Guidry prior to Board mandated supervision.
3. Ms. Guidry's supervisor shall be a licensed Clinical Social Worker-Board Approved Clinical Supervisor (LCSW-BACS). This supervision does not count towards supervision required for licensing as a LCSW.
4. Ms. Guidry shall comply with all Social Work Practice Act and Rules, Standards & Procedures during the term of her probation.
5. Mr. Guidry shall pay all legal costs associated with this Addendum to Consent Agreement and Order in the amount of THREE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$375.00) within one (1) year from the date all parties sign this Addendum to Consent Agreement and Order. The payments shall be made on a quarterly basis *(with the first payment of Ninety-three Dollars * 75 / 100 (\$93.75)).*

6. Ms. Guidry specifically acknowledges that failure to comply with the terms of this Addendum to Consent Agreement and Order may result in a denial,

revocation, or suspension of any license, certificate, or registration issued by, or applied for, in accordance with La. R.S. 37:2717.

Waiver of Rights. Licensee is aware that she has the right to consult with an attorney of her choice and understands she has the right to an administrative hearing on the facts in this case. She understands and agrees that by signing this Addendum, she is waiving her rights to a hearing. Further, she understands and agrees that she is relieving the prosecutor of any burden it has of proving the facts admitted above. Licensee further understands and agrees that by signing this Addendum she is voluntarily and knowingly giving up her right to present oral and documentary evidence, to present rebuttal evidence, to cross-examine witnesses against her, and to appeal the Board's decision.

Effect of Non Acceptance of Agreement. Licensee and the prosecutor agree that this Addendum is subject to the approval of the Board. They agree that, if the Board rejects this Addendum, it will be void, and an Administrative Complaint may be filed. If this Addendum is rejected by the Board it will not constitute a waiver of licensee's right to a hearing on the matters alleged in an administrative complaint and the admissions contained herein will have no effect. Licensee agrees that, if the Board rejects this Addendum, the Board may decide the matter after a hearing, and its consideration of this Addendum shall not alone be grounds for claiming that the Board is biased against her that it cannot fairly decide the case, or that it has received ex parte communication.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this Addendum to Consent Agreement and Order shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board and is a public record of the Board. The terms of this Addendum to Consent Agreement and Order may be published and reported, including but not limited to, the LABSWE Newsletter, the Association of Social Work Boards (ASWB), and the National Practitioner Data Bank-Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank (NPDB-HIPDB).

The prosecutor acknowledges negotiation and preparation of this Addendum to Consent Agreement and Order in order to resolve, with prejudice, all matters for which the social worker could be charged under Complaint 2009-82 and further certifies that this Addendum to Consent Agreement and Order is consistent with the evidence, adequately addresses the complaint, and represents a true and correct statement of that which could be proven at a hearing of this matter.
