CONSENT AGREEMENT AND ORDER

WHEREAS, LUKE KLEIN ("Mr. Klein") is a credentialed social worker subject to the

jurisdiction and the rules and regulations of the Louisiana State Board of Social Work Examiners

("Board" or "LABSWE");

WHEREAS, on November 2, 2022, the Board received a complaint against Mr. Klein

from the Director of the LSU School of Social Work, where Mr. Klein was a student. The

complaint alleged that a report was made about Mr. Klein through LSU's Behavioral Incident

Reporting System on August 31, 2022, which was investigated by LSU Police and Louisiana State

Police. The report indicated that Mr. Klein made statements to a co-worker regarding his intent to

act out violently and to harm children when practicing as a social worker. Also included was a

portion of a novel written by Mr. Klein in which he cast himself as the main character that

contained extremely disturbing content;

WHEREAS, by letter dated December 6, 2022, the Board notified Mr. Klein of the

complaint filed against him, provided Mr. Klein with a summary of the nature of the complaint,

and requested that Mr. Klein, within fifteen (15) days, provide a written response giving his review

of the allegations raised in the complaint;

WHEREAS, by correspondence on December 24, 2022, Mr. Klein responded to the complaint, giving his response to the allegations contained therein, generally denying much of the allegations contained in the complaint;

WHEREAS, pursuant to a complaint and an administrative investigation, Mr. Klein has indicated his desire to resolve this matter through a Consent Agreement and Order as provided for in Rule No. 907 of the Board's Rules, Standards and Procedures and La. R.S. 49:955(D) of the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act;

WHEREAS, Mr. Klein has admitted to the following:

- 1. Mr. Klein is a Registered Social Worker ("RSW") registered by the Board to engage in the practice of social work in the State of Louisiana pursuant to the Social Work Practice Act, La. R.S. 37:2701 et. seq., as evidenced by RSW No. 17340.
- 2. At the time of the complaint, Mr. Klein was a student in the online MSW program at LSU.
- 3. Mr. Klein is not currently working as a social worker nor in an internship.
- 4. Mr. Klein made statements that could be perceived as a threat to the safety of the public.

WHEREAS, making statements that could be perceived as a threat to the safety of the public, Mr. Klein violated La. R.S. 37:2717(A)(5), (12), and La. Admin. Code tit. 46:XXV §117(A).

WHEREAS, undersigned counsel has confirmed Mr. Klein's desire to resolve this matter through a Consent Agreement and Order;

WHEREAS, Mr. Klein agrees not to repeat the misconduct mentioned in this Consent Agreement and Order, and acknowledges that any further misconduct mentioned in this Consent

Agreement and Order will be considered a violation of the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order and shall be cause for further disciplinary action;

WHEREAS, Mr. Klein recognizes his right to have an administrative adjudication of the charges outlined in the complaint and notice letter, at which time Mr. Klein would be entitled to be represented by legal counsel, to call witnesses, and to present witnesses on his behalf in defense or in mitigation of the charges made, and to a decision thereon by the Board based upon written findings of fact and conclusions of law in accordance with the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act. Mr. Klein nonetheless waives his right to formal adjudication and, pursuant to La. R.S. 49:955(D), consents to the entry of the Consent Agreement and Order set forth hereinafter. Mr. Klein also acknowledges that he waives any rights to which he may be entitled pursuant to the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act, La. R.S. 49:951, et seq., or which he otherwise may be afforded by any law, to contest his agreement to, or the force and effect of this Consent Agreement and Order, in any Court or other forum.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in consideration of the foregoing and pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by La. R.S. 49:955(D), the Board orders and Mr. Klein accepts the following administrative action which is a final decision pursuant to La. R.S. 49:958:

- Mr. Klein shall be evaluated by the Louisiana State Board of Social Work
 Examiners' Impaired Professional Program (IPP) at his expense within thirty (30)
 days from the date that all parties sign this Consent Agreement and Order. Mr.
 Klein shall follow all recommendations of the designated IPP evaluator in a timely
 manner.
- 2. Mr. Klein shall not engage in the practice of social work until he has been evaluated by the designated IPP evaluator and cleared to return to practice.

- 3. Mr. Klein shall pay all costs associated with Complaint 2023-59 in the amount of \$1,237.50 within (12) months after the date all parties sign this Consent Agreement and Order. The payments shall be made on a quarterly basis with the first payment due within ninety (90) days from the date all parties sign this Consent Agreement and Order. The payments shall be made by credit card, certified check, or money order.
- 4. Mr. Klein specifically acknowledges that failure to comply with the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order may result in a denial, revocation, or suspension of any license, certificate, or registration issued by, or applied for, in accordance with La. R.S. 37:2717.
- 5. Mr. Klein shall report the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order to any board or agency with which he is licensed or registered.
- 6. By agreeing to the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order, Mr. Klein waives all rights to appeal this adjudication.

Effect of Non-Acceptance of Agreement. Mr. Klein acknowledges that this Consent Agreement and Order is subject to the approval of the Board. He further acknowledges and agrees that if the Board rejects this Consent Agreement and Order, it will be void, and an Administrative Complaint may be filed relative to the allegations contained herein. If this Consent Agreement and Order is rejected by the Board, it will not constitute a waiver of Mr. Klein's right to a hearing on the matters alleged in an Administrative Complaint and the admissions contained herein will have no effect. He further agrees that if the Board rejects this Consent Agreement and Order, the members of the Board may decide the matter after a hearing, and their consideration of this Consent Agreement and Order shall not alone be grounds for recusal of any member of the Board,

including any claims that the Board is biased against him, that it cannot fairly decide the case, or that it has received ex parte communication.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this Consent Agreement and Order shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board and is a public record of the Board. The terms of this Consent Agreement and Order may be published and reported in, including but not limited to, the LABSWE Newsletter, the Association of Social Work Boards (ASWB), and the National Practitioner Data Bank-Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank (NPDB-HIPDB).

The prosecutor acknowledges negotiation and preparation of this Consent Agreement and Order in order to resolve, with prejudice, all matters for which the social worker could be charged under Complaint 2023-59, and further certifies that this Consent Agreement and Order is consistent with the evidence, adequately addresses the complaint, and represents a true and correct statement of that which could be proven at a hearing of this matter.

R.S. 49:955(D), in lieu of the institution and prosecution of formal administrative proceedings, and accordingly consent to the entirety of the Order set forth above and further waive any right to which I may be entitled under the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act or any other law to contest, in any court, my agreement to this Order. By my subscription hereto, I also hereby authorize the Prosecutor to present this Order to the LABSWE for its consideration and to disclose to and discuss with the LABSWE the nature and results of the investigation of this matter. I herein waive any objection to such disclosure based on due process of law under either the State or Federal Constitution or under State statutory law, including La. R.S. 49:960. I expressly acknowledge that the disclosure of such information to the LABSWE shall be without prejudice to the Prosecutor's authority to file a formal Administrative Complaint, or the LABSWE's capacity to adjudicate such Administrative Complaint, should the LABSWE decline to approve this Consent Agreement and Order. I further acknowledge my awareness that should the LABSWE approve this Consent Agreement and Order that the Consent Agreement and Order will become a matter of public record.
