CONSENT AGREEMENT AND ORDER

WHEREAS, Tartiana Citizen (“Ms. Citizen”) was a credentialed social worker subject to the jurisdiction and the rules and regulations of the Louisiana State Board of Social Work Examiners (“Board” or “LABSWE”);

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2022, Ms. Citizen filed a self-report with the Board to disclose that on July 31, 2021, she was arrested in Texas for driving under intoxication and possession of controlled substances;

WHEREAS, by letter dated September 12, 2022, the Board notified Ms. Citizen of its receipt of her self-report, and requested that Ms. Citizen, within fifteen (15) days, submit: (1) a copy of all official documents regarding the arrest; and (2) information regarding the current disposition of the arrest;

WHEREAS, pursuant to a complaint and an administrative investigation, Ms. Citizen has indicated her desire to resolve this matter through a Consent Agreement and Order as provided for in Rule No. 907 of the Board’s Rules, Standards and Procedures and La. R.S. 49:975(D) of the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act;

Initial: 

WHEREAS, Ms. Citizen has admitted to the following:

1. Ms. Citizen was a Certified Social Worker (“CSW”), licensed by the Board to engage in the practice of social work in the State of Louisiana pursuant to the Social Work Practice Act, La. R.S. 37:2701 et. seq., as evidenced by License Number 14166.
2. Ms. Citizen was arrested for a misdemeanor DUI and a Controlled Substance Charge in the State of Texas on July 31, 2021. Ms. Citizen failed a sobriety test. Upon searching the vehicle, the police found pills in her glove compartment. Ms. Citizen denied that the pills belonged to her.
3. Ms. Citizen reported the arrest to the Board on August 2, 2022.
4. Ms. Citizen has not engaged in the practice of social work since her arrest.

WHEREAS, by failing to notify the Board of her arrest within seven (7) business days of the arrest, Ms. Citizen violated La. R.S. 37:2717(A)(5) and La. Admin. Code tit. 46:XXV §117(E).

WHEREAS, undersigned counsel has confirmed Ms. Citizen desires to resolve this matter through a Consent Agreement and Order;

WHEREAS, Ms. Citizen agrees not to repeat the misconduct mentioned in this Consent Agreement and Order, and acknowledges that any further misconduct mentioned in this Consent Agreement and Order will be considered a violation of the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order and shall be cause for further disciplinary action;

WHEREAS, Ms. Citizen recognizes her right to have an administrative adjudication of the charges outlined in the complaint and notice letter, at which time Ms. Citizen would be entitled to be represented by legal counsel, to call witnesses, and to present witnesses on her behalf in defense or in mitigation of the charges made, and to a decision thereon by the Board based upon written findings of fact and conclusions of law in accordance with the Louisiana Administrative

Procedure Act. Ms. Citizen nonetheless waives her right to formal adjudication and, pursuant to La. R.S. 49:975(D), consents to the entry of the Consent Agreement and Order set forth hereinafter. Ms. Citizen also acknowledges that she waives any rights to which she may be entitled pursuant to the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act, La. R.S. 49:951, et seq., or which she otherwise may be afforded by any law, to contest her agreement to, or the force and effect of this Consent Agreement and Order, in any Court or other forum.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in consideration of the foregoing and pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by La. R.S. 49:975(D), the Board orders and Ms. Citizen accepts the following administrative action which is a final decision pursuant to La. R.S. 49:977:

1. Ms. Citizen shall be evaluated by the Louisiana State Board of Social Work Examiners' Impaired Professional Program (IPP) at her expense prior to the Board approving any application for a social work credential. Ms. Citizen shall follow all recommendations of the designated IPP evaluator in a timely manner.
2. Ms. Citizen shall not engage in the practice of social work until she is deemed fit to practice by the designated IPP evaluator.
3. Ms. Citizen shall reimburse legal costs associated with Complaint No. 2023-34 in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$570.00) within one (1) year from the date all parties sign this Consent Agreement and Order. The payments shall be made on a quarterly basis with the first payment due within ninety (90) days from the date all parties sign this Consent Agreement and Order. Payment shall be made by credit card, certified check, or money order.

4. Ms. Citizen understands that this Consent Agreement and Order relates only to her failure to timely notify the Board of her arrest. The Board reserves the right to further discipline Ms. Citizen based on the result of her criminal case.
5. Ms. Citizen specifically acknowledges that failure to comply with the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order may result in a denial, revocation, or suspension of any license, certificate, or registration issued by, or applied for, in accordance with La. R.S. 37:2717.
6. Ms. Citizen further acknowledges that failure to reimburse the fees set forth above at Paragraph 3 will require the Board to take further action in collection of this debt. Respondent has twelve (12) months to reimburse the expenses before the debt will be considered final and transferred to the Louisiana Office of Debt Recovery (ODR). After transfer, the debt is subject to an additional collection fee of up to twenty-five percent (25%) of the total debt liability, as provided for in LA R.S. 47:1676 (E).
7. Ms. Citizen shall report the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order to any board or agency located in the United States with which she is licensed or registered.
8. By agreeing to the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order, Ms. Citizen waives all rights to appeal this adjudication.

Effect of Non-Acceptance of Agreement. Ms. Citizen acknowledges that this Consent Agreement and Order is subject to the approval of the Board. She further acknowledges and agrees that if the Board rejects this Consent Agreement and Order, it will be void, and an Administrative Complaint may be filed relative to the allegations contained herein. If this Consent Agreement and Order is rejected by the Board, it will not constitute a waiver of Ms. Citizen's right to a hearing on the matters alleged in an Administrative Complaint and the admissions contained herein will have


no effect. She further agrees that if the Board rejects this Consent Agreement and Order, the members of the Board may decide the matter after a hearing, and their consideration of this Consent Agreement and Order shall not alone be grounds for recusal of any member of the Board, including any claims that the Board is biased against her, that it cannot fairly decide the case, or that it has received ex parte communication.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this Consent Agreement and Order shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board and is a public record of the Board. The terms of this Consent Agreement and Order may be published and reported in, including but not limited to, the LABSWE Newsletter, the Association of Social Work Boards (ASWB), and the National Practitioner Data Bank-Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank (NPDB-HIPDB).

The prosecutor acknowledges negotiation and preparation of this Consent Agreement and Order in order to resolve, with prejudice, all matters for which the social worker could be charged under Complaint 2023-34, and further certifies that this Consent Agreement and Order is consistent with the evidence, adequately addresses the complaint, and represents a true and correct statement of that which could be proven at a hearing of this matter.

R.S. 49:975(D), in lieu of the institution and prosecution of formal administrative proceedings, and accordingly consent to the entirety of the Order set forth above and further waive any right to which I may be entitled under the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act or any other law to contest, in any court, my agreement to this Order. By my subscription hereto, I also hereby authorize the Prosecutor to present this Order to the LABSWE for its consideration and to disclose to and discuss with the LABSWE the nature and results of the investigation of this matter. I herein waive any objection to such disclosure based on due process of law under either the State or Federal Constitution or under State statutory law, including La. R.S. 49:977.2. I expressly acknowledge that the disclosure of such information to the LABSWE shall be without prejudice to the Prosecutor's authority to file a formal Administrative Complaint, or the LABSWE's capacity to adjudicate such Administrative Complaint, should the LABSWE decline to approve this Consent Agreement and Order. I further acknowledge my awareness that should the LABSWE approve this Consent Agreement and Order that the Consent Agreement and Order will become a matter of public record.







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
