CONSENT AGREEMENT AND ORDER

WHEREAS, Anita Hall (“Ms. Hall”) is a credentialed social worker subject to the jurisdiction and the rules and regulations of the Louisiana State Board of Social Work Examiners (“Board” or “LABSWE”);

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2022, a complaint against Ms. Hall was filed with the Board by Ms. Hall’s supervisor at Longleaf Hospital (“LLH”). The complaint described concerns about Ms. Hall engaging in unprofessional and/or unethical conduct including (1) failing to submit notes/reports in a timely manner; and (2) practicing under a mental condition that impairs her ability to safely practice;

WHEREAS, by letter dated September 29, 2022, the Board notified Ms. Hall of the complaint filed against her, provided Ms. Hall with a summary of the nature of the complaint, and requested that Ms. Hall, within fifteen (15) days, provide a written response giving her review of the allegations raised in the complaint;

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated October 14, 2022, Ms. Hall responded to the complaint, giving her response to the allegations contained therein;

WHEREAS, pursuant to a complaint and an administrative investigation, Ms. Hall has indicated her desire to resolve this matter through a Consent Agreement and Order as provided for

in Rule No. 907 of the Board's Rules, Standards and Procedures and La. R.S. 49:975(D) of the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act;

WHEREAS, Ms. Hall has admitted to the following:

1. Ms. Hall is a Certified Social Worker ("CSW"), licensed by the Board to engage in the practice of social work in the State of Louisiana pursuant to the Social Work Practice Act, La. R.S. 37:2701 et. seq., as evidenced by License Number 16950.
2. In September of 2022, Ms. Hall began to experience sickness and an altered mental state after receiving her Invega shot, which was prescribed by Alexandria Solutions, LLC and administered to her by her Longleaf Co-Worker, Stacy Creel, RN (Lic.# EX054830). Another Long Leaf Social Worker, Emily Friis, LCSW (Lic.# 14676) assisted Ms. Hall by transporting her to Rapides Medical Center where she was diagnosed with an altered mental status and a urinary tract infection.
3. Ms. Hall failed to timely submit notes because she could not keep up with work while being ill. Her employer reported that she had not completed 332 therapy notes prior to her resignation in September of 2022. Ms. Hall proffered her resignation after being placed on unpaid leave and being informed she was being investigated for not completing her notes. Ms. Hall stipulates to not completing her notes; however, she resigned after talking to her supervisor and upon her believe she would be terminated at the completion of the investigative action..

WHEREAS, by failing to submit notes/reports in a timely manner due to Ms. Hall's mental health emergency, Ms. Hall violated La. R.S. 37:2717(A)(5), La. Admin. Code tit. 46:XXV §111(G)(5) and §117(A).

WHEREAS, undersigned counsel has confirmed Ms. Hall's desire to resolve this matter through a Consent Agreement and Order;

WHEREAS, Ms. Hall agrees not to repeat the misconduct mentioned in this Consent Agreement and Order, and acknowledges that any further misconduct mentioned in this Consent Agreement and Order will be considered a violation of the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order and shall be cause for further disciplinary action;

WHEREAS, Ms. Hall recognizes her right to have an administrative adjudication of the charges outlined in the complaint and notice letter, at which time Ms. Hall would be entitled to be represented by legal counsel, to call witnesses, and to present witnesses on her behalf in defense or in mitigation of the charges made, and to a decision thereon by the Board based upon written findings of fact and conclusions of law in accordance with the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act. Ms. Hall nonetheless waives her right to formal adjudication and, pursuant to La. R.S. 49:975(D), consents to the entry of the Consent Agreement and Order set forth hereinafter. Ms. Hall also acknowledges that she waives any rights to which she may be entitled pursuant to the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act, La. R.S. 49:951, et seq., or which she otherwise may be afforded by any law, to contest her agreement to, or the force and effect of this Consent Agreement and Order, in any Court or other forum.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in consideration of the foregoing and pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by La. R.S. 49:975(D), the Board orders and Ms. Hall accepts the following administrative action which is a final decision pursuant to La. R.S. 49:977:

1. Ms. Hall shall be evaluated by the Louisiana State Board of Social Work Examiners' Impaired Professional Program (IPP) at her expense within 30 days

from the date that all parties sign this Consent Agreement and Order. Ms. Hall shall follow all recommendations of the designated IPP evaluator in a timely manner.

2. Ms. Hall shall not engage in the practice of social work until she has been evaluated by the designated IPP evaluator.
3. Ms. Hall shall continue receiving therapeutic and psychiatric treatment, and her therapist/psychiatrist shall make reports to the Board documenting her compliance with this Consent Agreement and Order. The reports shall be made on a quarterly basis.
4. Ms. Hall shall pay all costs associated with Complaint No. 2023-36 in the amount of \$592.50 within twelve (12) months after the date all parties sign this Consent Agreement and Order. The payments shall be made on a quarterly basis with the first payment due within ninety (90) days from the date all parties sign this Consent Agreement and Order. The payments shall be made by credit card, certified check, or money order.
5. Ms. Hall specifically acknowledges that failure to comply with the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order may result in a denial, revocation, or suspension of any license, certificate, or registration issued by, or applied for, in accordance with La. R.S. 37:2717.
6. Ms. Hall further acknowledges that failure to reimburse the fees set forth above at Paragraph 4 will require the Board to take further action in collection of this debt. Respondent has twelve (12) months to reimburse the expenses before the debt will be considered final and transferred to the Louisiana Office of Debt Recovery

(ODR). After transfer, the debt is subject to an additional collection fee of up to twenty-five percent (25%) of the total debt liability, as provided for in LA R.S. 47:1676 (E).

7. Ms. Hall shall report the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order to any board or agency with which she is licensed or registered.
8. By agreeing to the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order, Ms. Hall waives all rights to appeal this adjudication.


Effect of Non-Acceptance of Agreement. Ms. Hall acknowledges that this Consent Agreement and Order is subject to the approval of the Board. She further acknowledges and agrees that if the Board rejects this Consent Agreement and Order, it will be void, and an Administrative Complaint may be filed relative to the allegations contained herein. If this Consent Agreement and Order is rejected by the Board, it will not constitute a waiver of Ms. Hall's right to a hearing on the matters alleged in an Administrative Complaint and the admissions contained herein will have no effect. She further agrees that if the Board rejects this Consent Agreement and Order, the members of the Board may decide the matter after a hearing, and their consideration of this Consent Agreement and Order shall not alone be grounds for recusal of any member of the Board, including any claims that the Board is biased against her, that it cannot fairly decide the case, or that it has received ex parte communication.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this Consent Agreement and Order shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board and is a public record of the Board. The terms of this Consent Agreement and Order may be published and reported in, including but not limited to, the LABSWE Newsletter, the Association of Social Work Boards (ASWB), and the National Practitioner Data Bank-Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank (NPDB-HIPDB).

The prosecutor acknowledges negotiation and preparation of this Consent Agreement and Order in order to resolve, with prejudice, all matters for which the social worker could be charged under Complaint 2023-36, and further certifies that this Consent Agreement and Order is consistent with the evidence, adequately addresses the complaint, and represents a true and correct statement of that which could be proven at a hearing of this matter.

The admissions contained herein will be considered proven and the only issue will be failure to follow the terms of the Consent Agreement and Order. I make these acknowledgements and waivers in support of a final disposition of the pending investigation of Complaint No. 2023-36 by Consent Agreement and Order pursuant to La. R.S. 49:975(D), in lieu of the institution and prosecution of formal administrative proceedings, and accordingly consent to the entirety of the Order set forth above and further waive any right to which I may be entitled under the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act or any other law to contest, in any court, my agreement to this Order. By my subscription hereto, I also hereby authorize the Prosecutor to present this Order to the LABSWE for its consideration and to disclose to and discuss with the LABSWE the nature and results of the investigation of this matter. I herein waive any objection to such disclosure based on due process of law under either the State or Federal Constitution or under State statutory law, including La. R.S. 49:977.2. I expressly acknowledge that the disclosure of such information to the LABSWE shall be without prejudice to the Prosecutor's authority to file a formal Administrative Complaint, or the LABSWE's capacity to adjudicate such Administrative Complaint, should the LABSWE decline to approve this Consent Agreement and Order. I further acknowledge my awareness that should the LABSWE approve this Consent Agreement and Order that the Consent Agreement and Order will become a matter of public record.
