





I monitor Donald's progress and professional development needs. As a supervisor it is my responsibility to be aware if any of my supervisee LMSWs are in need of additional individual sessions. Donald is aware that despite if maximum number of hours allowed, if it is necessary to adjust or increase the number of clinical individual supervision sessions, we will do this. His supervision method will be based on what is warranted for the best interests of his practice, growth and development towards receiving his LCSW.

The clinical supervision group is capped at 4 group members (note: the rule allows 5) to ensure that supervisees are able to receive the adequate time and attention they need.

Planned discussions, role plays, presentations, and other strategic assignments where others are involved help to develop him and better prepare him for the LCSW examination.

Participation in group sessions with activities such as case discussions and assigned presentations also allow for better observation of some of the required 10 supervision evaluation elements (for example: *Relationship with other professionals* and *intervention process*).

Donald is diligent, interested in learning, and he also makes significant contribution and provides feedback from his work environment, which is working with persons receiving psychiatric treatment.





Since the beginning of Covid several years ago, it has become increasingly difficult to find continuing education in person. Most providers in Maryland and Virginia have switched to online courses for continuing education. I have been able to maintain my certification in Louisiana successfully. This certification period (Since September 1, 2023), I have been unable to find any in person continuing education near me in order to obtain the ten required hours of in person continuing education, with the exception of finding one course locally that may count toward approximately six of the hours.
