CONSENT AGREEMENT AND ORDER

WHEREAS, Julia Beaudine ("Ms. Beaudine") is a credentialed social worker subject to .
the jurisdiction and the rules and regulations of the Louisiana State Board of Social Work
Examiners ("Board" or "LABSWE");

WHEREAS, the Board received a complaint against Ms. Beaudine wherein it was alleged that Ms. Beaudine was advertising herself within Louisiana as a therapist. Follow up investigation revealed that Ms. Beaudine was taking private appointments for therapy within Louisiana.

WHEREAS, by letter dated February 23, 2023, the Board notified Ms. Beaudine of the complaint filed against her, provided Ms. Beaudine with a summary of the nature of the complaint, and requested that Ms. Beaudine provide a response to the complaint;

WHEREAS, by letter dated February 27, 2023, Ms. Beaudine responded to the complaint, giving her response to the allegations contained therein;

WHEREAS, in accordance with La R.S. 37:2724(B), which allows for the CSW to be held for no more than three (3) years from the issuance of the original certificate, Ms. Beaudine's CSW expires on August 20, 2024;

WHEREAS, pursuant to a complaint and an administrative investigation, Ms. Beaudine has indicated her desire to resolve this matter through a Consent Agreement and Order as provided

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for in Rule No. 907 of the Board's Rules, Standards and Procedures and La. R.S. 49:975(D) of the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act;

WHEREAS, Ms. Beaudine has admitted to the following:

1. Ms. Beaudine is a Certified Social Worker ("CSW") licensed by the Board to engage in the practice of social work in the State of Louisiana pursuant to the Social Work Practice Act, La. R.S. 37:2701 et. seq., as evidenced by License Number 16793.

2. Ms. Beaudine was practicing outside the scope of her licensure and without proper supervision by advertising herself within Louisiana as a therapist and taking private appointments for therapy within Louisiana.

3. Ms. Beaudine was practicing hypnotherapy and Rapid Resolution Therapy services in the state of Louisiana and in doing so recognizes that these services are not permitted to be conducted independently as defined by La. Admin Code tit. 46:XXV §301 under the licensure guidelines of CSW.

WHEREAS, by practicing outside the scope of her licensure without proper supervision, Ms. Beaudine violated La. R.S. 37:2724(C), 37:2717(A)(5), La. Admin Code tit. 46:XXV §109(C), 303(B), (D), & (E), 501, and 505.

WHEREAS, undersigned counsel has confirmed Ms. Beaudine's desire to resolve this matter through a Consent Agreement and Order;

WHEREAS, Ms. Beaudine agrees not to repeat the misconduct mentioned in this Consent Agreement and Order, and acknowledges that any further misconduct mentioned in this Consent Agreement and Order will be considered a violation of the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order and shall be cause for further disciplinary action;

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WHEREAS, Ms. Beaudine recognizes her right to have an administrative adjudication of the charges outlined in the complaint and notice letter, at which time Ms. Beaudine would be entitled to be represented by legal counsel, to call witnesses, and to present witnesses on her behalf in defense or in mitigation of the charges made, and to a decision thereon by the Board based upon written findings of fact and conclusions of law in accordance with the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act. Ms. Beaudine nonetheless waives her right to formal adjudication and, pursuant to La. R.S. 49:975(D), consents to the entry of the Consent Agreement and Order set forth hercinafter. Ms. Beaudine also acknowledges that she waives any rights to which she may be entitled pursuant to the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act, La. R.S. 49:951, et seq., or which she otherwise may be afforded by any law, to contest her agreement to, or the force and effect of this Consent Agreement and Order, in any Court or other forum.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in consideration of the foregoing and pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by La. R.S. 49:975(D), the Board orders and Ms. Beaudine accepts the following administrative action which is a final decision pursuant to La. R.S. 49:977:

- The CSW credential of Ms. Beaudine to be engaged in the practice of social work shall be and is hereby REPRIMANDED. Accordingly, Ms. Beaudine accepts and shall maintain strict compliance with the following terms and conditions.
- 2. Julia Beaudine shall not apply for a social work credential in the State of Louisiana for at least one (1) year from the date all parties sign this Consent Agreement and Order. Should Ms. Beaudine apply for a social work credential after such time, and subject to Board approval of the application, the credential shall be issued under probationary status and remain under probation for a period of one (1) year.

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- 3. Upon the Board's approval of a social work credential for Ms. Beaudine, Ms. Beaudine shall complete twelve (12) months of supervised social work practice occurring at a frequency of one (1) hour per month and provided by a Board Approved Clinical Supervisor, during which time her credential will stay on probation. The BACS shall make quarterly reports on Ms. Beaudine's progress to the Board. Ms. Beaudine agrees to release the disciplinary file associated with Complaint No. 2023-110 to the BACS.
- 4. Ms. Beaudine shall pay a fine in the amount of SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$750.00) within one (1) year from the date all parties sign this Consent Agreement and Order. The payments shall be made on a quarterly basis with the first payment due within ninety (90) days from the date all parties sign this Consent Agreement and Order. Payment shall be made by credit card, certified check, or money order.
- 5. Ms. Beaudine shall reimburse legal costs associated with Complaint No. 2023-110 in the amount of SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO DOLLARS AND 50/100 (\$652.50) within one (1) year from the date all parties sign this Consent Agreement and Order. The payments shall be made on a quarterly basis with the first payment due within ninety (90) days from the date all parties sign this Consent Agreement and Order. Payment shall be made by credit card, certified check, or money order.
- 6. Any future Board approval of a social work credential for Ms. Beaudine shall be conditioned upon her completion, in addition to the requirements set forth in the Social Work Practice Act, of six (6) hours of continuing education in the area of ethics, within the time frame to be assigned by the Board. These hours are to be

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pre-approved by the Board prior to completion. These continuing education hours must be completed in addition to all standard renewal requirements for her licensure.

7. Any future Board approval of a social work credential for Ms. Beaudine shall be conditioned upon her completion, in addition to the requirements set forth in the Social Work Practice Act, and passing the Board's Open Book Examination on the Social Work Practice Act and Rules, Standards & Procedures, within the time frame to be assigned by the Board.

8. Ms. Beaudine specifically acknowledges that failure to comply with the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order may result in a denial, revocation, or suspension of any license, certificate, or registration issued by, or applied for, in accordance with La. R.S. 37:2717.

9. Ms. Beaudine further acknowledges that failure to reimburse the fees set forth above at Paragraphs 4 and 5 will require the Board to take further action in collection of this debt. Respondent has twelve (12) months to reimburse the expenses before the debt will be considered final and transferred to the Louisiana Office of Debt Recovery (ODR). After transfer, the debt is subject to an additional collection fee of up to twenty-five percent (25%) of the total debt liability, as provided for in La. R.S. 47:1676 (E).

10. Ms. Beaudine shall report the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order to any board or agency with which she is licensed or registered.

11. By agreeing to the terms of this Consent Agreement and Order, Ms. Beaudine waives all rights to appeal this adjudication.

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Agreement and Order is subject to the approval of the Board. She further acknowledges and agrees that if the Board rejects this Consent Agreement and Order, it will be void, and an Administrative Complaint may be filed relative to the allegations contained herein. If this Consent Agreement and Order is rejected by the Board, it will not constitute a waiver of Ms. Beaudine's right to a hearing on the matters alleged in an Administrative Complaint and the admissions contained herein will

Effect of Non-Acceptance of Agreement. Ms. Beaudine acknowledges that this Consent

have no effect. She further agrees that if the Board rejects this Consent Agreement and Order, the

members of the Board may decide the matter after a hearing, and their consideration of this

Consent Agreement and Order shall not alone be grounds for recusal of any member of the Board,

including any claims that the Board is biased against her, that it cannot fairly decide the case, or

that it has received ex parte communication.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this Consent Agreement and Order shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board and is a public record of the Board. The terms of this Consent Agreement and Order may be published and reported in, including but not limited to, the LABSWE Newsletter, the Association of Social Work Boards (ASWB), and the National Practitioner Data Bank-Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank (NPDB-HIPDB).

The prosecutor acknowledges negotiation and preparation of this Consent Agreement and Order in order to resolve, with prejudice, all matters for which the social worker could be charged under Complaint 2023-110, and further certifies that this Consent Agreement and Order is

By my subscription hereto, I also hereby authorize the Prosecutor to present this Order to the LABSWE for its consideration and to disclose to and discuss with the LABSWE the nature and results of the investigation of this matter. I herein waive any objection to such disclosure based on due process of law under either the State or Federal Constitution or under State statutory law, including La. R.S. 49:977.2. I expressly acknowledge that the disclosure of such information to the LABSWE shall be without prejudice to the Prosecutor's authority to file a formal Administrative Complaint, or the LABSWE's capacity to adjudicate such Administrative Complaint, should the LABSWE decline to approve this Consent Agreement and Order. I further acknowledge my awareness that should the LABSWE approve this Consent Agreement and Order that the Consent Agreement and Order will become a matter of public record,
